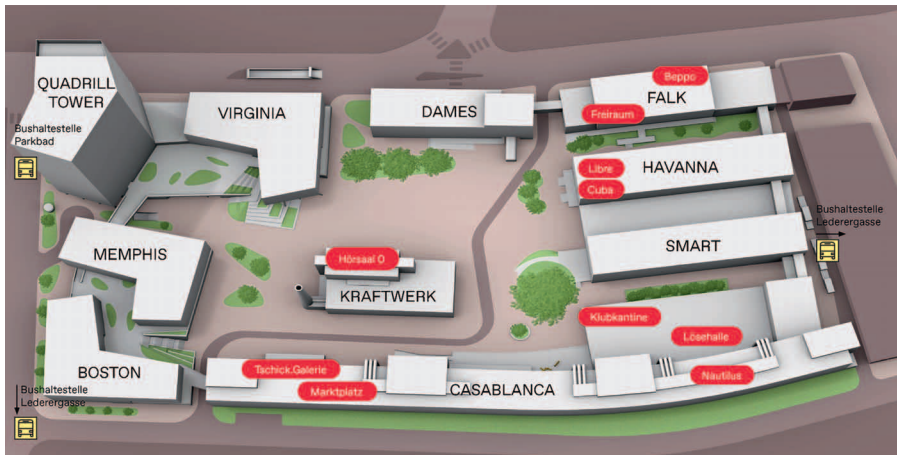

Öffentliche Anreise

Die Tabakfabrik ist durch mehrere Buslinien direkt an den Linzer Hauptbahnhof und das Stadtzentrum angebunden:

- **Linie 12 & 25:** Haltestelle **Parkbad** oder Haltestelle **Lederergasse**
- **Linie 26:** Haltestelle **Parkbad**.
- **Linie 27:** Haltestelle **Schlachthof**
- **Linie 72:** Haltestelle **Parkbad**.
- **Anreise mit dem Auto & Parken**

Die Anfahrt erfolgt meist über die **A7 Mühlkreisautobahn** (Abfahrt Hafenstraße), von der die Tabakfabrik nur etwa 5 Minuten entfernt liegt.

- **Quadrill Tiefgarage:** Die Einfahrt erfolgt über die Untere Donaulände und ausschließlich stadteinwärts befahrbar ist. Im Areal der Tabakfabrik.
- **Parkbad-Tiefgarage (P1):** Nur ca. 100 Meter entfernt und die primäre Option für Besucher.
- **APCOA Tiefgarage Medicent (P2):** Ebenfalls in unmittelbarer Gehdistanz.
- **Kurzparkzone:** In den umliegenden Straßen (meist gebührenpflichtig, teilweise bis zu 90 Minuten kostenlos).

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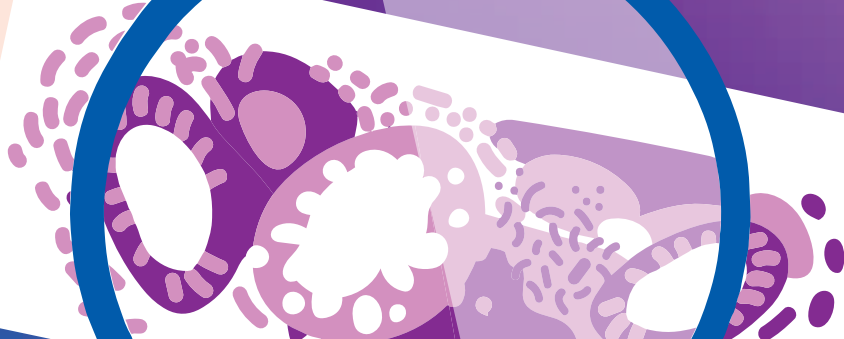
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
