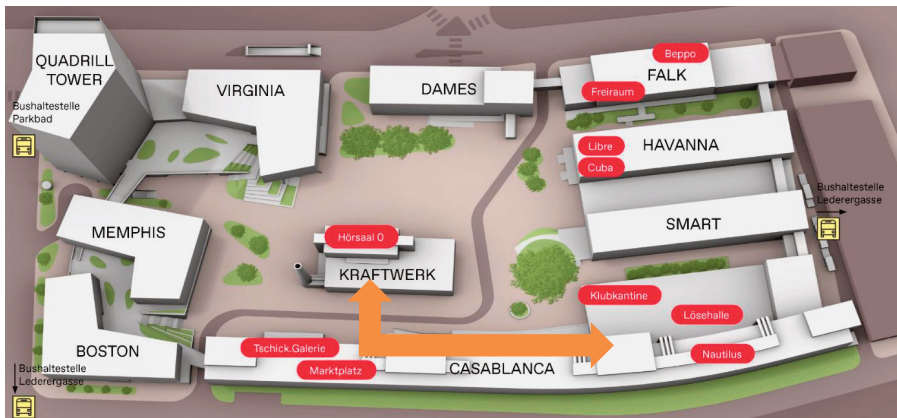

# Venue and Transport Information

The presentations will take place in Lecture Hall 0, and registration and the trade exhibition will be held in the Lösehalle



## Public Transportation

The Tabakfabrik is directly connected to Linz Central Station and the city center by several bus lines:

- **Lines 12 & 25:** Parkbad stop or Lederergasse stop
- **Lines 26:** Parkbad stop
- **Lines 27:** Schlachthof stop
- **Lines 72:** Parkbad stop
- **Getting There by Car & Parking**

Most visitors arrive via the A7 Mühlkreis Highway (Hafenstraße exit), from which the Tabakfabrik is only about 5 minutes away.

- **Quadrill Underground Parking Garage:** The entrance is on Untere Donaulände and is accessible only when traveling toward the city center. Located on the Tabakfabrik grounds.
- **Parkbad Underground Parking Garage (P1):** Only about 100 meters away and the primary option for visitors.
- **APCOA Medicent Underground Parking Garage (P2):** Also within walking distance.
- **Short-term parking zone:** In the surrounding streets (mostly metered, with some offering up to 90 minutes of free parking).
- **Courtyard:** Parking in the courtyard is generally not permitted (except for accessible parking spaces and delivery vehicles with special permits).

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
